Re: Recertification - Warren County Triangle North Site

Dear Ms. Tai:

Warren County is seeking recertification of an industrial site as part of the Kerr-Tar Region's Hub Project. Warren County Public Utilities is the water/wastewater service provider for the Warren County industrial site.

Warren County owns a 10" water main within the right-of-way of S.R. 1100 that serves the site. As part owner of the Kerr Lake Regional Water System, Warren County owns 20 percent of the 10 million gallon per day capacity of the water treatment plant. Our daily demand currently stands at approximately one million gallons per day, leaving a remaining allocation of one million gallons per day. The 10" line maintains a constant pressure of 63 psi fed by a 250,000 elevated storage tank in Manson.

Warren County Public Utilities is the service provider for the wastewater industrial site. Warren County owns an existing 8" gravity sewer directly across S.R. 1100 from the site. Service can be easily extended to the site but will require pumping to offset elevation changes; currently there are no stations on the undeveloped site. Warren County also owns a 2.0 million gallon per day wastewater treatment plant in Warrenton, as part of the county sewer system. Current load on the facility is approximately 400,000 gallons per day at regular operating ranges, leaving an excess capacity of 1.6 million gallons per day. The county's wastewater treatment plant employs the extended aeration process with tertiary filters and chlorination.

Warren County Public Utilities is proud to be a part of this project. We look forward to working with the North Carolina Department of Commerce. If additional information is needed, please do not hesitate to contact this office.
